Today's memory reminded me how long it has been since I've connected with my friend Kevis. I met Kevis working at the Melting Pot back in 2011. We became friends and eventually started going to the gym together. Most of the time it was after a shift somewhere between midnight and 2am. And man, we would just TORTURE each other; whoever was spotting would constantly call the other out for poor form or not completing a set, and then hand down some kind of punishment, usually in the form of push ups. We pushed each other to no end, to the point where it was comical, and you would hear responses like: "C'mon man are you KIDDING ME!?! That was perfect form!!" but there was no appeal process, if the spotter said "that's an extra 5 pushups" you always did it, no matter what. It was hilarious. If the spotter was particularly unforgiving, they knew they were gonna get it twice as bad when it was their turn to do whatever the workout was. To this day I have never been more miserable and had more fun in the gym than those late nights at Planet Fitness.

If you didn't know Kevis, let me tell you; he was such a good dude, a friend to me, incredibly kind to everyone he interacted with, and so many other things besides the best gym partner I ever had. I remember we first bonded over American Sign Language, I was taking it in college and he learned it because his sister is deaf. I think about what else he would be today had he not been senselessly killed. I think about if there was anything I could have done to prevent the end of his life.

Rest in peace buddy, I love you, I miss you. Until we meet again, and when we do you're going to owe me so many pushups.
