KoShema began her career in the healthcare industry in 1996 working for multiple healthcare providers until she went to work for the state's largest healthcare provider Christiana Care Hospital with 21 years of service.

KoShema was loved and respected on her job. She also worked part-time for We Care Home Care of Delaware for 5 years as a home healthcare provider. Her ministry included a love for the word of God, a heart for the youth, and compassion for all. She was a prayer warrior; she would pray for anyone in need instantly. Koky was a strong woman of God, never wavering in her faith and belief in Jesus.

She was understanding but stern and loved to spoil her grandchildren every chance she could. She loved her children and grandchildren wholeheartedly. Her family was the main source of her joy.
