Lewis Edward Lynch, Jr., was born on December 4, 1946, in Hollister, North Carolina to the late Jesse Spruill and Lewis Lynch. He was one of seven children. He spent his early years in Hollister, North Carolina before relocating to Delaware, where he spent most of his life.

In 1965, Lewis met Maggie (Peggy) Pearson at a local county fair in North Carolina. After a year of dating, the couple married on July 1, 1966, in Emporia, Virginia. They had one daughter, Tamela (Tammy) Lynch in October of 1967 and a bonus daughter, Vernay O'Neal in November of 1976.

Lewis spent most of his adult life as a machine operator for two major chemical plants, Aamco Refinery and General Chemicals. However, he is most known for his side hobbies such as car repair and lawn mower maintenance. He also had a small lawn care business that he shared with his daughter and granddaughters. He was known as the jack of all trades, but the master of none.
