Melvin Tyrone (Tye) Henderson, 66, son of the late Ethel A. Henderson and late Gerald O. Brown Sr., was born on May 1, 1959, in Wilmington, Delaware. He departed this life on March 15, 2026, at Regal Heights Healthcare & Rehabilitation Center in Hockessin, DE surrounded by his family and friends.

Melvin received his early education in the City of Wilmington Public School Systems. Melvin attended Howard Career Center, where he studied carpentry and graduated in June 1977. It was there that he began learning the skills and craftsmanship that would later become the foundation of his career. Melvin worked for Brandywine Building Services and Creative Arts Centers. He also worked alongside prestige's contractors, Jake Spence and Chester Triplett.

In 1980, Melvin answered the call to serve his country by enlisting in the United States Army. During his years of service, he spent time stationed in Germany, proudly serving with dedication and discipline. After completing his time in active duty, Melvin continued his commitment to service by also serving in the Army Reserves. He later received an Honorable Discharge as a SP4 carrying with him the experience and strength gained through his military service.

Melvin had a love for sports and competition. He enjoyed playing softball (The Spoilers), flag football and watching his favorite NFL team Green Bay

Packers. When Melvin was around, there was always conversation and good times. He enjoyed hanging out with his "Davis Street Crew". You can say he was the life of the party. His favorite saying was "One Love".

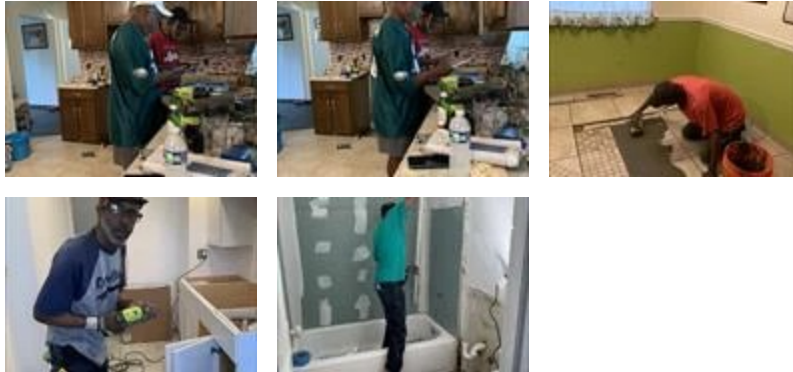
