Later Raheen become interested in cutting hair and decided to continue his education, earning his certification as a barber from the American Barber Academy. Working his craft for different employers sparked an interested in Raheen of financial freedom for his family and employment independence. This led to taking a chance on himself and acting on his entrepreneurial Spirit. KB Carpet and Upholstery Cleaning Service was created, naming the business after his son "King-Bey".
